Somerset Regional Communications Center is pleased to announce the Friendly Caller Program. If you choose to register, we will be able to stay in contact with you on a daily basis.

If you are on our list as a daily "call-in" to our Center, you should call us daily (7 days a week) between the hours of 7:00am and 11:00am. Please call us at 1-877-200-9070 or 474-6788. When you call please tell the dispatcher who you are and that you are making your daily call.

If you do not call us on any day we will call your home. If we do not make contact with you then we ask an officer to stop by your home to be sure you are ok. It is very important that you call us ahead of time if you are not going to be able to call. For example, you might be going shopping or going to a doctor's appointment.

As soon as we get your information sheet back we can get you started on the program. Someone from our Center will call you when you are ready to start. If you do not hear back in a few days after you send your sheet back, please do not hesitate to call me at 474-6788.

Names and Telephone numbers of two people to call if we do not hear from you:

If we do not hear from you and cannot reach you by phone we will send a deputy or officer to check on you. If we need to enter your house, in an emergency, or perceived emergency, is there a spare key hidden and where can it be found? If someone has a spare key, what is their name, address and phone number?

The subscriber will need to call into the Communications Center every day between 7:00am and 11:00am to let the dispatcher know that they are alright or that they need some assistance. The number to call is 474-6788 or 1-877-200-9070. If you are going to be away during those hours you will need to let the Communications Center know ahead of time. If you do not call, someone will attempt to call you and/or your designated alternate person. Should we not be able to contact you or your alternate contact, we will request that an officer make a courtesy stop by your house to confirm that you are safe.
